As required by the New Jersey Department of Education, our district contracted Whitman Environmental, an environmental engineering consultant, this past 2024-2025 school year to test the quality of the district's water sources at all schools and determine if there was any presence of lead. The test results are posted on the district website.

At the site of Frances C. Smith Early Childhood Center School No. 50, a water fountain was in need of remediation and was shut down.

Elizabeth Public Schools will continue to be vigilant and proactive in its approach to maintaining a safe and secure learning environment to better allow students to focus on achieving at high levels.
