Course Description

Welcome to Marine Corps JROTC! LE-1 introduces you to leadership, teamwork, discipline, physical fitness, and citizenship. This course helps you build confidence and responsibility while learning what it means to be part of a team. You will learn in the classroom, through physical activities, and by wearing the Marine Corps uniform with pride.

Course Objectives

- Learn and demonstrate leadership and self-discipline
- Understand Marine Corps history, values, customs, and structure
- Improve your citizenship and decision-making skills
- Participate in physical training, drill, and uniform inspections
- Show respect for self, others, and your community
- Represent yourself and the Corps with pride

Cadet Expectations

- Follow the Marine Corps values: Honor, Courage, and Commitment
- Wear the uniform properly and proudly on assigned days
- Keep a clean and groomed appearance (Marine Corps grooming standards apply)
- Respect instructors, classmates, and the American flag
- Follow all school and JROTC rules
- Participate in all class, physical, and extracurricular activities
- Bring required materials to class daily (notebook, pen, laptop)

Uniform and Grooming

Uniform Days: Monday-Friday (or as directed)

• Uniform must be clean, ironed, and worn correctly

- Hair and grooming must meet Marine Corps standards
- Cadets who don't wear their uniform will receive a zero for the week—no exceptions

Grading Policy

Category	Weight
Physical Fitness	20%
Tests/Quizzes (Academics)	20%
Uniform Inspection/Drill	40%
Conduct	10%

Important: Missing uniform days, poor attendance, or inappropriate behavior will lower your grade.

Tiered Intervention and Discipline

Tier 1 – General Expectations (Most Cadets)

- All cadets are expected to meet attendance, behavior, and academic standards
- Uniform, grooming, and behavior expectations are reviewed weekly
- Teachers and parents communicate regularly if problems begin

Tier 2 – Targeted Support

If a cadet:

- Misses uniform day 2+ times
- Struggles with behavior or attendance
- Fails to maintain a passing grade

Then:

- A parent conference is scheduled
- A behavior or performance contract is created
- Cadet receives extra help or mentoring
- Weekly progress reports are shared with parents

Tier 3 – Intensive Support

If problems continue:

- A student success plan is developed with administration
- Cadet may be referred for alternative education support
- May result in rank reduction, disenrollment, or removal from program

Discipline Guidelines

Cadets may face consequences for:

- Repeated uniform violations (3 or more per marking period)
- Failing JROTC or multiple other classes

- Disrespect, inappropriate behavior, or misuse of social media
- Poor attitude or motivation
- Violating school rules or Marine Corps values

Disciplinary actions may include:

- Verbal/Written counseling
- Referral to school administration
- Reduction in rank
- Failing grade
- Removal from the JROTC program

Parent Contact & Communication

- Parents may contact instructors by phone, email, or in person
- Parent meetings are held as needed for support or concerns
- Instructors will notify parents if academic or behavior issues arise
- Parents are encouraged to attend JROTC events and ceremonies

- Show growth in leadership, self-discipline, and citizenship
- Understand Marine Corps structure and values
- Demonstrate basic drill and inspection skills
- Improve fitness and teamwork
- Be prepared for success in future JROTC levels and life
