

#### Summer Math Practice for Incoming 5th Graders


Dear Students,

As you know, this coming September, you will be learning math at a 6<sup>th</sup> grade level in your 5<sup>th</sup> grade math classroom. To brush up on your 5<sup>th</sup> grade math skills and prepare you for the 6<sup>th</sup> grade math curriculum, it is important to practice and work to refine your skills during the summer months. You will use the Khan Academy website to gain an advantage and be better prepared for the coming school year. This will allow you extra practice and the opportunity to work at your own pace. Your work should be completed from June through August. Attached are directions on how to connect to your math teachers through Khan Academy and how to begin. Your math teachers will be monitoring your progress and you will receive credit for your hours spent on Khan Academy in September when you return to school. Please plan to work on Khan Academy for at least 100 minutes per week. Try to set up a schedule for yourself. (For example: You may choose to work for 25 minutes on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday). You may use your home computer, a computer at the library or a friend or relative's computer. Be sure that you log in each time you visit Khan Academy to receive credit for your work! You should have at least 75% complete of "Get ready for 6<sup>th</sup> Grade" by September 2024.



**OBJECTIVE:** Increase our Understanding of Literature Through Meaningful, Interpretive, and Evaluative Analysis, Discussion, and Presentation

Signpost	Task [a Brief Overview of each Signpost]	Literary Elements	Annotation Symbol
Contrasts and Contradictions	A sharp contrast between what we would expect and what we observe the character doing; behavior that contradicts previous behavior or well-established patterns.  A character behaves or thinks in a way we don't expect, or an element of a setting is something we would not expect. Aha Moment	A character's realization of something that shifts his actions or understanding of himself, others, or the world around him.  Phrases, usually expressing suddenness, like:  "Suddenly I understood"  "It came to me in a flash that"  "The realization hit me like a lightning bolt"  "In an instant I knew"  How might this change things?	- Character development - Internal conflict - Plot	Aha
Tough Questions	Questions a character raises that reveal his or her inner struggles.  Phrases expressing serious doubt or confusion: "What could I possibly do to?" "I couldn't imagine how I could cope with" "How could I ever understand why she?" "Never had I been so confused about" What does this question make me wonder about?	- Internal conflict - Theme - Character development	???
Words of the Wiser	The advice or insight a wiser character, who is usually older, offers about life to the main character.  The main character and another are usually off by themselves, in a quiet, serious moment, and the wiser figure shares his wisdom or advice in an effort to help the main character with a problem or a decision.  What's the life lesson, and how might it affect the character?	- Theme - Internal conflict - Theme - Relationship between character and plot	WW
Again and Again	Events, images, or particular words that recur over a portion of the novel.  A word is repeated, sometimes used in an odd way, over and over in the story.  An image reappears several times during the course of the book. Memory Moment	A recollection by a character that interrupts the forward progress or the story.  The ongoing flow of the narrative is interrupted by a memory that comes to the character, often taking several paragraphs to recount before we are returned to events of the present moment. 

TEXT CLUE: CHARACTERS SAY "I REALIZED" OR "I SUDDENLY KNEW" OR "NOW I KNOW WHY . . . "

### **QUESTION: HOW MIGHT THIS CHANGE THINGS?**






#### contrasts and contradictions

<u>DEFINITION</u>: THE CHARACTER ACTS IN A WAY THAT IS CONTRADICTORY OR UNEXPECTED GIVEN HOW HE OR SHE NORMALLY ACTS.

<u>TEXT CLUE</u>: AUTHOR SHOWS FEELINGS OR ACTIONS THE READER HASN'T SEEN BEFORE OR DOESN'T EXPECT.

## QUESTION: WHY IS THE CHARACTER DOING THAT?






#### Tough questions

<u>DEFINITION</u>: THE CHARACTER ASKS A TOUGH QUESTION THAT REVEALS HIS OR HER CONCERNS [INTERNAL CONFLICT].

TEXT CLUE: THE CHARACTER ASKS HIMSELF OR HERSELF A DIFFICULT QUESTION.

QUESTION: WHAT DOES THIS QUESTION MAKE ME WONDER ABOUT? WHAT DOES IT TELL ME ABOUT THE CHARACTER?







#### words of the wiser

<u>DEFINITION</u>: AN OLDER CHARACTER (MENTOR, ADVISOR, PARENT, ETC.) GIVES ADVICE OR AN INSIGHT TO THE MAIN CHARACTER.

TEXT CLUE: A WISER, OFTEN OLDER, CHARACTER OFFERS A LIFE LESSON, USUALLY IN A QUIET MOMENT.

# QUESTION: WHAT'S THE LIFE LESSON, AND HOW MIGHT IT AFFECT THE CHARACTER?






### **Again** and Again

<u>DEFINITION</u>: THE AUTHOR KEEPS BRINGING UP THE SAME IMAGE, PHRASE, OR REFERENCE.

TEXT CLUE: A REPEATED IMAGE, PHRASE, OR REFERENCE.

## QUESTION: WHY DOES THIS KEEP SHOWING UP AGAIN AND AGAIN?






## ${\color{red} \textbf{memory moment}} - \textbf{Flashback}$

<u>DEFINITION</u>: THE AUTHOR INTERRUPTS THE FLOW OF THE STORY BY LETTING THE CHARACTER REMEMBER SOMETHING.

TEXT CLUE: "I SUDDENLY REMEMBERED ... "; "I REMEMBER ... "; OR "THINKING BACK ... "
