The first day of the 2021-2022 school year is just three weeks away on **Thursday, September 9th** and we are working diligently to prepare and welcome your children safely back to school. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of an upcoming vaccination clinic that the district will be hosting in collaboration with Union County.

The Centers for Disease Control, the American Academy of Pediatricians, and the New Jersey Department of Health all advocate for both the wearing of a mask and the vaccination as effective measures in mitigating the transmission of the COVID-19 virus. Additionally, the vaccination is the leading public health prevention strategy to end the COVID-19 pandemic and to help schools safely return to in-person learning as well as extracurricular activities and sports.

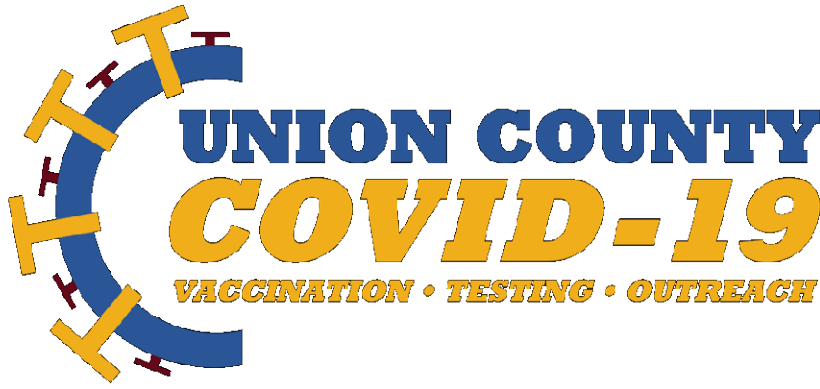
