CHILDREN and ADULTS UNDER AGE 65

NJ FamilyCare is publicly funded health coverage for NJ residents. It provides free or low cost quality health care. The NJ FamilyCare program includes CHIP, Medicaid and Medicaid expansion populations.

What's Covered?

NJ FamilyCare offers full health care coverage through health plans contracted by the state.

NJ FamilyCare covers most health care needs including:

- doctor visits
- x-rays
- eyeglasses
- prescriptions
- hospitalization
- mental health services
- lab tests
- dental
- specialist visits

Who is Eligible:

Qualified NJ residents of any age can be eligible for NJ FamilyCare. This includes children, parents, caretaker relatives, and adults without dependent children. Eligibility is based on the income and household size that was reported on applicant's latest federal tax return. However, NJ FamilyCare can use other sources, such as pay stubs, to verify information. Income eligibility for children is higher than income eligibility for adults. (See chart)

What Does it Cost?

For many people, NJ FamilyCare will cost nothing: no monthly premiums or co-payments.

For higher income families with children there is a sliding scale for co-payment's and monthly premiums.

Are There Any Restrictions?

Pre-existing conditions do not affect eligibility. In most cases, children must be without medical insurance for at least 3 months to qualify. Because there are exceptions, it is a good idea to call NJ FamilyCare in case you have a question.

Adults must have Legal Permanent Resident status for at least five years to be eligible. Children and pregnant women, regardless of their date of entry into the U.S., can be eligible if they are legal residents. For undocumented residents, their children may be eligible if born in the U.S.

NJ FamilyCare es un seguro de salud con financiamiento público para residentes de NJ. Proporciona atención médica gratuita o a bajo costo. El programa NJ FamilyCare incluye CHIP, Medicaid y poblaciones para expansión de Medicaid.

¿Qué está cubierto?

NJ FamilyCare ofrece cobertura de atención médica completa a través de planes de salud contratados por el estado. NJ FamilyCare cubre la mayoría de las necesidades de atención médica, incluso:

- consultas al médico
- medicamentos de venta con receta
- análisis de laboratorio
- radiografías
- hospitalización
- cuidado dental
- anteojos
- servicios de salud mental
- visitas a especialistas

Quién es elegible: Los residentes de NJ de cualquier edad pueden ser elegibles para NJ FamilyCare. Esto incluye hijos, padres, parientes cuidadores y adultos sin niños dependientes. La elegibilidad se basa en el ingreso y el tamaño de la familia que se reportaron en la declaración de impuestos federales más reciente del solicitante. Sin embargo, NJ FamilyCare puede usar otras fuentes, como por ejemplo comprobantes de sueldo, para verificar información. La elegibilidad por ingreso para los niños es mayor que la elegibilidad por ingreso para los adultos. (Consulte la tabla)

¿Cuánto cuesta?

Para muchas personas, NJ FamilyCare no costará nada: sin primas mensuales ni copagos.

Para las familias con mayores ingresos que tienen hijos hay una escala variable para copagos y primas mensuales.

¿Hay alguna restricción? Las condiciones preexistentes no afectan la elegibilidad. En la mayoría de los casos, los niños tienen que haber estado sin seguro médico por lo menos durante 3 meses para ser elegibles. Debido a que hay excepciones, le recomendamos llamar a NJ FamilyCare si tiene alguna pregunta.

Los adultos deben tener condición legal de residente permanente durante al menos cinco años para ser elegibles. Los menores de edad y las mujeres embarazadas, independientemente de la fecha en que entraron en Estados Unidos, pueden ser elegibles si son residentes legales. Los hijos de residentes indocumentados podrían ser elegibles si nacieron en Estados Unidos.
