
Why are Scholarships Important?


Create Going Merry Account

Enter your name and email or click "Sign up with Google", then verify your email



- Once your profile is 100% complete, your personalized dashboard will display readyto-apply opportunities




Browse Your Matched Scholarships

Hit "Start Application"


→ Opens the application form pre-filled with your profile info to save time.
