





ANNOUNCEMENT OF NEW STATEWIDE ASSESSMENTS




NJSLA-Adaptive and NJGPA-Adaptive Field Test Dates:

• Grades 9-12 October 28, 29, 30

• Grades 4-8 November 12, 13, 14

- The New Jersey Department of Education, in partnership with Cambium Assessment, Inc. (CAI), has announced the launch of the New Jersey Student Learning Assessments-Adaptive (NJSLA-Adaptive) and the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment-Adaptive (NJGPA-Adaptive).
- A key feature of these assessments is their adaptive format. As students progress through the test, future questions are
 determined based on their responses, creating a more personalized and appropriate experience for each learner.
- This approach can help reduce testing anxiety by presenting students with questions closer to their current level, encouraging confidence and focus.
- An adaptive assessment may also lead to more accurate results by measuring each student's performance with greater
 precision since the students will be receiving more items closer to their current level.
- The rollout of the NJSLA-Adaptive and the NJGPA-Adaptive will occur with a field test administration this fall for students in grades 4-12.

















EPS JOINS SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE NATION IN CELEBRATING AVID DAY


