The vigilance of all members of our school community is of utmost importance in keeping our community safe.

A Winfield Scott School No. 2 student reported yesterday that they were the target of an attempted luring near the school. We are currently working with the Elizabeth Police Department to provide as much information as possible and are taking action according to their recommendation and direction.

We have been informed that the suspect of the attempted luring was described as a light-skinned black male with dreadlocks who approached the student on foot.

All team members at School No. 2 have been made aware of the incident. Members of School No. 2 and the entire Elizabeth Public Schools professional learning community will continue to remain vigilant in keeping our schools and administrative offices safe and secure. We encourage you to also remain vigilant and to continually discuss with your children the importance of being aware of their surroundings and steps they should take when encountering unfamiliar people or strangers.
