Dear Parents/Guardians and Community Members:

Elizabeth Public Schools remains committed to both maintaining the safety of students, team members, and families while providing seniors of the graduating Class of 2020 with memorable ceremonies to suitably recognize their outstanding milestone achievements as we send them off to college and career success.

Governor Murphy recently announced that outdoor gatherings, while maintaining social distancing, will increase to 500 people after July 3. In accordance with the mandates and orders that have been put in place, graduation ceremonies will take place in July with the following provisions:

- Temperatures will be checked as individuals enter Williams Field. Anyone running a fever (over 100.4), including graduates, will not be allowed to attend or participate.
- Everyone will be required to wear a mask, including graduates.
- Graduates will receive **two tickets** each. The tickets will include a seat number. Limiting the number of guests and assigning them to seats at least six feet apart will ensure social distancing.
- Williams Field, including bleachers and seats, will be disinfected multiple times daily.
- Graduates will sit six feet apart during the ceremony.
- There will be no handshakes. Diplomas will be mailed home at a later date.
- Ceremonies will be condensed to approximately one hour to limit exposure.
- Graduates who are unable to participate in the ceremony will still be recognized during their high school's commencement. All of the ceremonies will be live streamed online
