The vigilance of all members of our school community is of utmost importance in keeping our community safe.

An Elizabeth Public Schools student reported this morning that they were the target of an attempted luring in the vicinity of Nicholas S. LaCorte – Peterstown School No. 3. We are currently working with the Elizabeth Police Department to provide as much information as possible and are taking action according to their recommendation and direction.

We have been informed that the suspect of the attempted luring was described as a Hispanic male with yellow glasses and a white shirt driving a gray car.

All team members at Nicholas S. LaCorte – Peterstown School No. 3 have been made aware of the incident. The Elizabeth Public Schools professional learning community will continue to remain vigilant in keeping our schools and administrative offices safe and secure. We encourage you also to remain vigilant and discuss with your children the importance of being aware of their surroundings and steps they should take when encountering unfamiliar people or strangers.
