Dear Parents/Guardians,

Elizabeth Public Schools remains committed to providing a high-quality education that prepares its students for college and career success.

New Jersey school districts, charter schools, and renaissance school projects are required by statute (N.J.S.A. 18A: 7C-6.6) to annually notify parents or guardians by October 1 of any statewide student assessment or commercially developed standardized assessment that will be administered over the course of the school year. On the next pages, please see the Elizabeth Public Schools' standardized assessment schedule for the 2025-2026 school year.

On August 13, 2025, the New Jersey Department of Education announced that the statewide assessments for English language arts and mathematics will be transitions to an adaptive assessment. The calendar set by the New Jersey Department of Education includes a field test of this new assessment this fall. We will be diligent and transparent in sharing the information about this assessment as it becomes available. The New Jersey Department of Education does have a web page for parents and families on which they will be posting information as well. The state assessments that will be administered by Elizabeth Public Schools during the 2025-2026 school year are the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA), NJGPA-Adaptive, ACCESS and Alternate ACCESS for English Language Learners (ELLs), Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) Year End (YE) Model, and New Jersey Student Learning Assessment-Adaptive (NJSLA-Adaptive).

National assessments administered during 2025-2026 will be the National Assessment for Educational Progress (NAEP) and College Board Assessments, which will include the Preliminary SAT (PSAT), Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT), and Advanced Placement (AP) tests in multiple subjects.

The administration of these assessments helps the district to set baseline performance levels for students and monitor and analyze their progress as they advance through their elementary and secondary education. These processes help determine the strengths and weaknesses of each student and inform the development of innovative and personalized learning plans to ensure every child can achieve excellence.
