Attendance and Tardiness Policy

Attendance and tardiness is strictly enforced. Failure to comply with stated guidelines will result in the student's removal from the school.

Attendance:

The following procedures are in place for monitoring student absence. If your child is absent for ten consecutive school days or absent intermittently fifteen days they will be transferred to their neighborhood school.

ABSENCE

- Day's 1-9 Phone calls from the school office will be made unless absence is reported.
- Day 10 Attendance officer visits home to review child's attendance status. A letter is sent home by administration notifying parents of the number of absences. Meeting with Attendance Task Force, parent, and child will be arranged. Parents may document extenuating circumstances at this time.
- Day 12 A letter will be sent home informing you that your child will lose his/her place at magnet school upon their fifteenth day of absence. The Attendance Task Force will update and review the case.
- Day 15 Child will be transferred to their neighborhood school.

Tardiness/ Early Dismissal

The following steps are in place for student tardiness and early dismissal. Please remember that students must report to school at 8:15 a.m. and are considered tardy at 8:20 a.m. Students arriving late due to bus complications will not be counted as tardy.

- Day 5 Phone call and/or letter will be sent out notifying parent/guardian that student is in danger of losing his/her place at magnet school.
- Day 10 Meeting with Attendance Task Force, parent, and child will be arranged. Parents may document extenuating circumstances at this time. Attendance Task Force will review case and attendance pattern.
- Day 12 A letter will be sent home informing you that your child will lose his/her place at magnet school upon their fifteenth day of tardiness. Attendance officer will make a visit to your home to insure you understand your child must report to school on time or they will be transferred to their neighborhood school. The Attendance Task Force will update and review case.
- Day 15 Child will be transferred to their neighborhood school.

Please understand that this policy is intended to give your child the benefit of our magnet program. Students who miss time from school are missing valuable school experience. If you have any questions regarding this policy, please do not hesitate to contact guidance counselor.
