Panorama Education- Grades 3 - 12, Panorama pulls key student information into one spot vis research-based surveys and gives Elizabeth schools a visual dashboard on every student. Panorama helps all schools move from just interpreting data to taking action and improving student outcomes. In EPS, students are surveyed in the following areas:

- Growth Mindset
- Emotional Regulation
- School Safety
- Teacher/Student Relationships

- Engagement
- Sense of Belonging
- Diversity and Inclusion
- Cultural Awareness and Action

Panorama Education (cont.) - Each school will create unique S.M.A.R.T goals after reviewing survey data to determine SEL areas in need of focus. Panorama also provides rich resources via the Panorama Playbook which enables all staff to incorporate SEL into everyday lessons. The goal of Panorama and every school is to improve students' Social Emotional Learning skills and to enhance positive culture and climate throughout each building.

Gaggle Therapy- Grades K-12, Students are facing a myriad of mental health challenges. Gaggle Therapy provides an easy way for Elizabeth schools to support student mental health through ongoing teletherapy sessions. Gaggle Therapy is free for all EPS students.

Social Emotional Learning After-School Program- Grades K – 12, EPS supports SEL ASPs at all 37 schools. The SEL ASP is specifically designed to provide Tier 2 interventions for a variety of student needs. Identified students will have exposer to the following therapeutic areas:

- Play Therapy
- Grief/Trauma
- Motivation
- Perseverance and Resilience

- Yoga
- Movement Therapy
- Meditation

Youth Enrichment Services (YES) program- Grades 9-12, Trinitas Regional Medical Center operates the YES program in 3 EPS high schools (Dwyer, Halsey, Jefferson). The YES program provides individual, family and group psychotherapy to high school students and their families.

Imagine Inc.- Grades K – 12, Imaine Inc. provides free, year-round grief support for children, families, and communities. Imagine Inc also is contracted to provide in-service training to all EPS staff in the areas of grief and trauma.

Therapeutic Learning Center- Grades K-12, In order to further cultivate a district wide school climate that continues to grow in its ability to be supportive of the emotional, and mental health of staff and students in the aftermath of the pandemic, Therapeutic Learning Connections will offer a social, emotional learning focused professional development trainings for school staff. TLC also provide workshops for EPS families focusing on the following areas:

- identify areas of SEL strength and growth
- apply social, emotional learning skills to decrease burnout and improve mental health
- define and utilize the tools in your social, emotional skills toolbox: 1.
 resilience 2. power, 3. completing the stress cycle, 4. living in the "and", 5.
 empathy, 6. compassionate accountability 7. vulnerability

Harmony Power- Grades K-12, Harmony Power is a SEL program specific design to combat bullying and promote a positive school culture and climate. Harmony Power awards are presented to students, staff, and families that embody the spirt of spreading goodness in school and the community.

Breaking the Cycle- Grades 6-12, Breaking the Cycle presents award-winning assemblies that feature personal stories of overcoming conflict through forgiveness. Their assemblies, whether in-person or live online, support our schools' social-emotional learning goals — and contribute to a positive school culture and climate. BTC speakers present examples of core competencies such as social awareness, relationship skills and responsible decision making from their own lives, which readily elicit discussion opportunities in the classroom.
